
COST OF PET OWNERSHIP IN 2025

This update to the **Synchrony Pet Lifetime of Care Study** reveals that while pet owners are spending more on their pets, there is a gap between **perceived and actual costs** for a **Lifetime of Care.**

Both **dog and cat owners** increasingly view pets as their family, child or best friend, indicating a cultural deepening of **emotional bonds.**



Caring for a dog over **15 years** now costs **\$22,125 to \$60,602** an average increase of 11.65%



For cats, the rise is even sharper: \$20,073 to \$47,106, an average increase of 19.4% from 2022



Small companion animal expenses, based on a 6-year lifespan, range from \$7,600 to \$14,938 (first year results)
